ArchiMapping is a Web App that allows the geolocation of 100 "must-see" examples of modern architecture in Milan from the Unification of Italy to the present day.

Our application does not collect, record or transfer user data to us.

The application does not collect statistical data on users and does not in any way require registration to access content.

The application allows access to and consultation of databases held by the Politecnico di Milano for which no personal information is collected except for that required for navigation and consultation of the content databases, but without requiring any form of identification.

You may save some of the architectural contents locally on your personal device.

The only personal information you exchange with us is when you freely and voluntarily write to us directly at the following email address (archimapping@polimi.it). By using the email, you implicitly consent to the use of your data (email, first name and last name) to enable a reply communication. We will then only process your contact data for the purpose of replying to you and will keep the data for the time strictly necessary to provide you with the appropriate feedback.

The application allows you to save content (e.g. favourite architectural works) on your device.

No data is disclosed or disseminated to third parties with the exception of the use of Google Maps to identify locations.
